Who is Bill T. Hicks?

Our scholarship is named after Bill T. Hicks, a former Y-12 Credit Union Board Chairman and educator in the Oak Ridge School System.

What are the scholarship awards?

The scholarship program includes six \$5,000 cash scholarships.

How do I apply?

Who is eligible?

High school students who are graduating in 2026 with a minimum GPA of 2.5 are eligible.

Do I have to be a member of Y-12 Credit Union to apply?

You must be a member of Y-12 Credit Union if you are selected as a scholarship recipient.

When does the application close?

The initial application will close at 11:59 p.m. EST on Dec. 19, 2025.

What is the application process?

Where do I upload the required documents?

When will applicants be notified?

Applicants will be notified by Feb. 27, 2026.

What happens after acceptance?

Scholarship recipients must return a letter of acceptance and proof of enrollment for the chosen institution within two weeks of enrollment confirmation. Failure to notify Y-12 Credit Union of acceptance will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
